The Maud City Council met in regular session on April 21st, 2025.

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Jimmy Porterfield.
- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Porterfield.
- 3. The Roll Call was made by City Clerk David Zeller. Present for the meeting were Council Members Lee Davis, Kurtis Dustman, Bobby Shatto and Chad Votaw. City Attorney Mat Thomas was also present. The Mayor Declared a Quorum.
- 4. The Mayor welcomed the visitors.
- 5. Randy Bower addressed the Council regarding people driving past his house in ATV's, and driving ATV's without a license and while under the influence of drugs.
- 6. Lee Davis moved to approve the consent agenda. Chad Votaw seconded. The vote was Davisaye, Votaw-aye, Dustman-aye, Shatto-aye. The Mayor declared the motion carried.

- 8. Police Chief Brawner reported that the PD had responded to 103 calls this month, including two deaths. One death was natural causes and the second one is under investigation. They also responded to several calls regarding goats.
- 9. Emergency Management Director Zeller discussed the unusually high rainfall that we have been experiencing. So far we have had some flooding but no damage reported.
- 10. Chad Votaw moved to approve General Fund Purchase Orders 10319 and 10322. Lee Davis seconded. The vote was Votaw-aye, Davis-aye, Dustman-aye, Shatto-aye. The Mayor declared the motion carried.
- 11. Clerk Zeller presented the preliminary budget for FY 25-26. Revenues are down slightly from last year. Additionally, instability in the economy is making the budget process more challenging this year.
- 12. Chad Votaw moved to approve the annual swimming pool agreement with Maud Schools. Bobby Shatto seconded. The vote was Votaw-aye, Shatto-aye, Davis-aye, Dustman-abstain. The Mayor declared the motion carried.
