

Minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of the City of Maud

April 20th, 2026

The Maud City Council met in regular session on April 20th, 2026.


1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Jimmy Porterfield.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Porterfield.
3. The Roll Call was made by City Clerk David Zeller. Present for the meeting were Council Members Lee Davis, Bobby Shatto and Chad Votaw. Tara Kestler was absent. City Attorney Mat Thomas was also present. The Mayor Declared a Quorum.
4. The Mayor welcomed the visitors.
5. No public comments.
6. Lee Davis moved to approve the consent agenda. Chad Votaw seconded. The vote was Davis-aye, Votaw-aye, Shatto-aye. The Mayor declared the motion carried.
7. No items removed.
8. Police Chief Casper Vinson reported that the PD responded to 21 Agency Assists, 7 Animal Complaints, 3 Vandalism Incidents, 1 Larceny Report, 3 Protective Order Violations, 5 Juvenile Related calls, 5 Mental Health calls, 2 Burglaries, 1 Unattended Death, 3 Warrant Services, 1 Fraud report, 2 Reckless Driver calls, 5 Domestic Incidents, 2 Civil Standby calls, and 1 Threat call. The Department participated in the Easter Egg hunt which was a great success. They assisted Earlsboro PD with a Donkey Basketball game. Chief Vinson completed Chief's School, and stated that he learned a lot and made many good contacts during the school. USDOJ/OJA conducted a compliance check of the department, and determined we were in compliance and spoke good things about our department. Chief Vinson is in contact with Harrah PD regarding Harrah donating several radios to our department. CPN is surplusng some dash cams and possibly some vehicles. The Seminole County Sheriff's Office is possibly donating 2 rifles to the department.
9. Emergency Management Director Zeller reported that he had opened the EOC several times for severe weather operations. He also assisted with the Easter Egg Hunt.
10. The Council discussed an Agreement with the Seminole County Detention Center. Clerk Zeller pointed out two discrepancies- The PD's address on page one is incorrect and Chief Vinson's name is misspelled on the signature page. Bobby Shatto moved to approve the agreement once the noted corrections are made. Chad Votaw seconded. The vote was Shatto-aye, Votaw-aye, Davis-aye. The Mayor declared the motion carried.

11. Clerk Zeller presented the preliminary budget for FY 2026-2027. The preliminary budget shows a Revenue deficit of approximately \$12,000.00 for the General Fund. He stated that he and the Mayor are still working on the Budget and the numbers will probably change before the final budget is presented in June.

12. Bobby Shatto moved to approve the Swimming Pool agreement with Maud Public Schools for this year. Lee Davis seconded. The vote was Shatto-aye, Davis-aye, Votaw-aye. The Mayor declared the motion carried.
