

Minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of the City of Maud

June 15th, 2026

The Maud City Council met in regular session on June 15th, 2026.

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Jimmy Porterfield.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Porterfield.
3. The Roll Call was made by City Clerk David Zeller. Present for the meeting were Council Members Lee Davis, Tara Kestler, Bobby Shatto and Chad Votaw. City Attorney Mat Thomas was also present. The Mayor Declared a Quorum.

13. Lee Davis moved to approve Budget Amendments 2026-01 thru 2026-06 for FY 25-26. Tara Kestler seconded. The vote was Davis-aye, Kestler-aye, Shatto-aye, Votaw-aye. The Mayor declared the motion carried.

14. Lee Davis moved to approve Resolution 2026-1, Approving the City of Maud Budget for FY 2026-2027, and Establishing Budget Amendment Authority. Tara Kestler seconded. The Vote was Davis-aye, Kestler-aye, Shatto-aye, Votaw-aye. The Mayor declared the motion carried.

15. Chad Votaw moved to approve Blanket Purchase Orders 10489 and 10490 for FY 2026-2027. Lee Davis seconded. The vote was Votaw-aye, Davis-aye, Kestler-aye, Shatto-aye. The Mayor declared the motion carried.

16. Chad Votaw moved to donate \$500.00 to the Fire Department for the annual 4th of July Fireworks show. Tara Kestler seconded. The vote was Votaw-aye, Kestler-aye, Davis-aye, Shatto-aye. The Mayor declared the motion carried.

17. Mayor Jimmy Porterfield addressed the council to request a special event permit for June 30th. Lee Davis moved to approve the permit. Tara Kestler seconded. The vote was Davis-aye, Kestler-aye, Shatto-aye, Votaw-aye. The Mayor declared the motion carried.

18. Amanda Needham addressed the council regarding having a cruise night in conjunction with the Masonic Lodge's benefit dinner for Teresa Wilkerson on July 11. Tara Kestler moved to approve the Cruise night. Lee Davis seconded. The vote was Kestler-aye, Davis-aye, Shatto-aye, Votaw-aye. The Mayor declared the motion carried.
