

Minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of the City of Maud


March 17, 2025

The Maud City Council met in regular session on March 17th, 2025.

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Jimmy Porterfield.
 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Porterfield.
 3. The Roll Call was made by City Clerk David Zeller. Present for the meeting were Council Members Lee Davis, Bobby Shatto and Chad Votaw. Kurtis Dustman was absent. City Attorney Mat Thomas was also present. The Mayor Declared a Quorum.
 4. The Mayor welcomed the visitors.
 5. No Public Comments.
 6. Lee Davis moved to approve the consent agenda. Chad Votaw seconded. The vote was Davis-aye, Votaw-aye, Shatto-aye. The Mayor declared the motion carried.
 7. No items removed.
 8. Police Chief Brawner reported that the PD had responded to 114 calls this month. They have been dealing with two sex offenders that recently moved into town. One of them has moved out. She has been working with OMAG and Lexipol to get the PD policies updated. She has hired a new reserve officer. He is not certified but will be going to Reserve Academy in April or May.
 9. Emergency Management Director Zeller reported that the Fire Department had responded to several fires in the last few days due to high winds and dry conditions.
 10. Chad Votaw moved to approve General Fund Purchase Orders 10289, 10292, 10293, 10297, 10298, 10299, 10301, 10302, and 10303. Bobby Shatto seconded. The vote was Votaw-aye, Shatto-aye, Davis-aye. The Mayor declared the motion carried.

11. The Council discussed the annual cleanup day. Lee Davis moved to set the Trash-off Days for April 12-13, and to open the Rodeo Grounds for Brush dumping on April 26-27. Chad Votaw seconded. The vote was Davis-aye, Votaw-aye, Dustman-aye, Shatto-aye. The Mayor declared the motion carried.
 12. The Council discussed RV's and travel trailers in the City. No action taken.
