


Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting of the Maud Municipal Authority

September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025

The Board of the Maud Municipal Authority met in regular session on September 15th, 2025.

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:25 PM by Chairman Jimmy Porterfield.
2. The Roll Call was made by Secretary to the Board David Zeller. Present for the meeting were Board Members Lee Davis, Bobby Shatto, and Chad Votaw. Kurtis Dustman was absent. City Attorney Mat Thomas was also present. The Chairman declared a quorum.
