

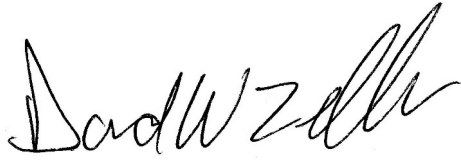
Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting of the Maud Municipal Authority

April 20th, 2026

The Board of the Maud Municipal Authority met in regular session on April 20th, 2026.

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:28 PM by Chairman Jimmy Porterfield.
2. The Roll Call was made by Secretary to the Board David Zeller. Present for the meeting were Board Members Lee Davis, Bobby Shatto, and Chad Votaw. Tara Kestler was absent. City Attorney Mat Thomas was also present. The Chairman declared a quorum.
3. The Chairman welcomed the visitors.
4. No Public Comments.
5. Chad Votaw moved to approve the consent agenda. Lee Davis seconded. The vote was Votaw-aye, Davis-aye, Shatto-aye. The Chairman declared the motion carried.
6. None Removed.
7. Public Works Superintendent Teresa Wilkerson reported that they have been using the new Jetter trailer. So far they have used it 5 times to jet lines. They repaired a sewer backup that was caused by a collapsed tap. Heath is in Class for his 'B' Lab licenses. They have been marking more of the grave lots on the new east side. She is still working on Code Enforcement. They installed a new water tap and several new autoread meters. They have been working on the clearing and dirt work for the fence at the Water Plant. The Electricity was out at the Water Plant for several hours on Friday. They replaced several stop signs. She is working on an OMAG grant for partial reimbursement for the jetter trailer.
8. Bobby Shatto moved to approve Purchase Orders 70779, 70783, and 70807. Lee Davis seconded. The vote was Shatto-aye, Davis-aye, Votaw-aye. The Chairman declared the motion carried.
9. Secretary Zeller presented the preliminary budget for FY 2026-2027. Current projections show a revenue shortfall of approximately \$96,000. The Chairman and Secretary are still working on the budget and those numbers will change before the final budget is approved in June.
10. Superintendent Wilkerson informed the Board that Electric Service Company contacted her and said they would not be able to do the wiring for the generator at the Water Plant due to a loss of employees. We will get new bids before next month's meeting.

11. Lee Davis moved to adjourn. Bobby Shatto seconded. The vote was Davis-aye, Shatto-aye, Votaw-aye. The Chairman declared the motion carried and adjourned the meeting at 7:53 PM.
