

Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting of the Maud Municipal Authority

July 20th, 2026

The Board of the Maud Municipal Authority met in regular session on July 20th, 2026.

1. The meeting was called to order at 8:07 PM by Chairman Jimmy Porterfield.
2. The Roll Call was made by Secretary to the Board David Zeller. Present for the meeting were Board Members Tara Kestler, Bobby Shatto, and Chad Votaw. Lee Davis was absent. City Attorney Mat Thomas was also absent. The Chairman declared a quorum.
3. The Chairman welcomed the visitors.
4. No Public Comments.
5. Bobby Shatto moved to approve the consent agenda. Tara Kestler seconded. The vote was Shatto-aye, Kestler-aye, Votaw-aye. The Chairman declared the motion carried.
6. None Removed.
7. Public Works Superintendent Teresa Wilkerson reported that they had installed a new 2" autoread meter at the housing authority. They finished trimming out the garage door at the water plant. They got the concrete slab poured for the generator fuel tank at the water plant. They have been mowing and weedeating the cemetery and city properties. They installed one new water tap. We have a leak on Oak and a Fire Hydrant leak on Douglas that they will be fixing in the near future. They had to replace the chemical pump at the Wastewater Plant. They installed 2 autoread meters this month. They replaced 100' of water main on Timmons. They fixed a leak on Harrison. They picked up the new pump for the north lift station.
8. Chad Votaw moved to approve Purchase Order 70864. Tara Kestler seconded. The vote was Votaw-aye, Kestler-aye, Shatto-aye. The Chairman declared the motion carried.
9. The Board discussed adding a charge for customer requested meter re-reads. Bobby Shatto moved to table the item pending a written draft of the policy. Chad Votaw seconded. The vote was Shatto-aye, Votaw-aye, Kestler-aye. The Chairman declared the item tabled.
10. Secretary Zeller informed the Board that Fenix, the company that provides our auto-read meter system has been purchased by Next Meters. They are migrating to a new portal, but it shouldn't affect our operations to any great extent.
11. Chad Votaw moved to adjourn. Tara Kestler seconded. The vote was Votaw-aye, Kestler-aye, Shatto-aye. The Chairman declared the motion carried and adjourned the meeting at 8:30 PM.
