

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART 6, COURTS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MAUD, INCREASING TECH FEE AND ADDING A TRAINING FEE, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF MAUD, OKLAHOMA, THE FOLLOWING:**

SECTION 1, AMENDMENTS:

1. Section 6-132, TECHNOLOGY FEE.

Strike the phrase Ten Dollars(\$10.00) and replace with the phrase Twenty-five Dollars(\$25.00).

2. Insert the following as Section 6-133:

SECTION 6-133 Section 6-133 TRAINING FEE

A. Whenever a person either commits an act that is prohibited or declared to be unlawful or a misdemeanor, or fails to perform any required act, the failure of which is declared to be unlawful or a misdemeanor and that person is punished by a fine, there shall be added to each fine a training fee in the amount of Ten Dollars (\$10.00). This fee is to be placed in a training account of the Police Department Equipment Reserve Fund, where the funds can be spent only for police training courses, training supplies, and other costs associated with ongoing training of Officers.

B. This fee shall be independent of any fines, costs, or fees that may be assessed from citations issued to any person for violation of traffic laws or other ordinance violations and in addition to any fees owed to any other person.

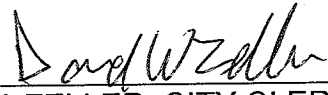
3. Renumber current sections 6-133 and 6-134 as sections 6-134 and 6-135 respectively.

SECTION 2 SEVERABILITY:

If any one or more of the sections, sentences, clauses or part of this ordinance, chapter or section shall for any reason be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, clause or part shall not affect or prejudice in any way the applicability and validity of any other provision of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council of the City of Maud that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.
